Now that May is here and we have had a few successful tournaments and a great 4 Person Scramble, I want to tell you about the McGladrey Team Championship. The McGladrey is sponsored by the PGA of America and our local qualifier is Saturday, May 31. The event is a 3 person one best ball out of three net. There are maximum handicap limits for men's teams, mixed teams, and women's teams, with each player playing off 50% of their tournament handicap. We need 7 teams to hold a local qualifier, and if we get 14 teams, we get to send 2 to the Section. Cost is per player is \$75 that includes a Team Championship sports duffel, a custom box of Titleist golf balls, carts and green fees for the event. The winners of the local qualifier will be joined by Bill or myself and move on to the Central New York PGA Section qualifier at Kanon Valley on Monday, August 11th. Section winners then advance to Pinehurst #2 on October 20-22 for the National McGladrey Championship. You can get an entry form in the Pro Shop or sign up and
